



SEMI- ANNUAL REVIEW OF THE FTSE4GOOD INDICES

SEPTEMBER 2009

This paper provides the details of the September 2009 FTSE4Good Semi-Annual index review. The FTSE4Good Policy Committee has approved all constituent changes.

1. INCLUSIONS

Thirty-three companies will be added to the FTSE4Good Index Series at this review. The table below shows the nationality of these companies (see Appendix 1 for names and sectors).

2. DELETIONS

Fifteen companies will be deleted from the FTSE4Good Index Series (see sections 2.1 - 2.4 for details) at this review. Appendix 2 lists all the deleted companies.

The FTSE4Good inclusion criteria evolve over time, demanding continued improvement in corporate responsibility practices in order to gain or maintain inclusion in the index. FTSE's in-house Responsible Investment Unit undertakes an extensive global engagement program with all FTSE4Good companies affected by new criteria requirements. Companies are made aware of the deadlines and what steps they have to take.
