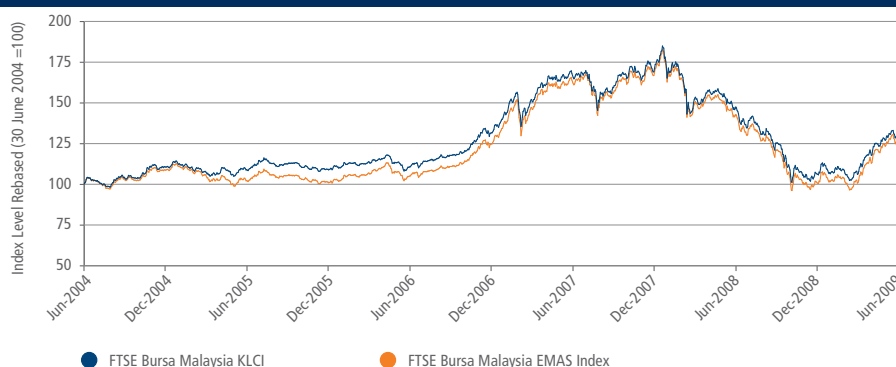


FTSE BURSA MALAYSIA KLCI

Malaysia's headline index, the Kuala Lumpur Composite Index (KLCI) is now enhanced and known as FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI. Part of the FTSE Bursa Malaysia Index Series, the 30 stock tradable index is representative, liquid and transparent providing domestic and international investors with an enhanced index to access the Malaysian market.

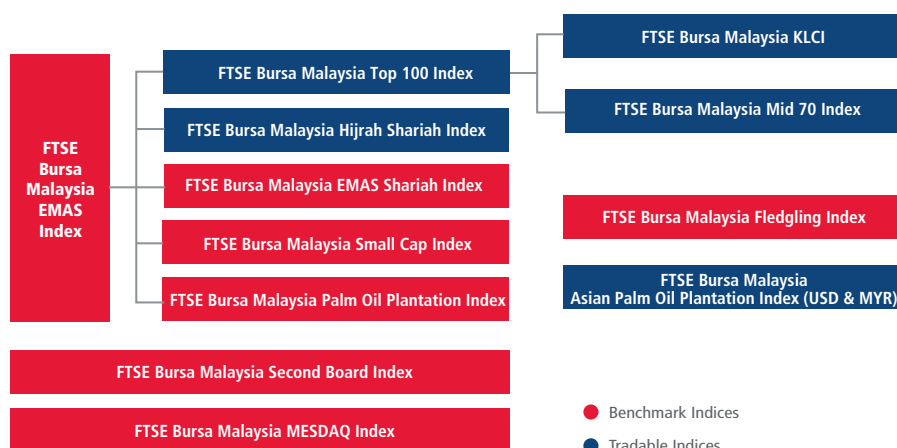

FEATURES

- The FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI represents the top 30 companies by market capitalization, on the Bursa Malaysia Main Board that pass the relevant investability screens
- The FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI is the headline index of the FTSE Bursa Malaysia Index Series, which comprises a total of 13 indices
- The index has been designed for the creation of structured products, index tracking funds, ETFs and other derivatives
- Existing products using this index as the underlying include FBMKLCIetf, FKLI and OKLI
- Stocks are free-float weighted to ensure that only the investable opportunity set is included with the index
- Stocks are liquidity screened to ensure that the index is tradable
- Capital and total return indices are available

INDUSTRY CLASSIFICATION BENCHMARK (ICB)

The index is calculated in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), a global standard developed in partnership between FTSE Group and Dow Jones Indexes

- ICB contains four classification levels: Industries (x10), Supersectors (x19), Sectors (x41) and Subsectors (x114)
- ICB is the globally accepted standard and has been adopted by institutions and stock exchanges
- ICB represents over 65% of the world's market capitalisation
